Blendon Seminary



This building of the Blendon Young Men's Seminary was the first to be erected on the 27 acres of land donated by Matthew and Peter Westervelt for the Seminary. The structure was 44 feet long and 26 wide with a bell cupola in its gabled ridge. It contained a chapel, Library room, and three recitation rooms. Later it was destroyed by fire.
