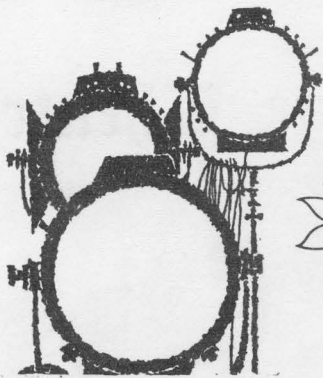

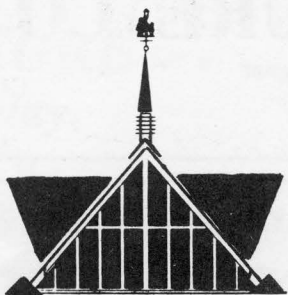

Director's Corner

Nostalgia is omnipresent in the arts today. In the theatre we seem to get real and continuing satisfaction from evocations of the 20's and 30's in musicals such as *The Boy Friend*, *No, No Nanette* and *Follies*. We are concerned with a much earlier era in *Life With Father* and it's easy to feel that life in the 1880's must have been glorious fun, at least for those as privileged as the Days and their friends. Actually there is a double nostalgia because the play reminds us also of that somewhat happier theatrical scene of thirty years ago when the Lindsay-Crowe collaboration broke all the records for the longest Broadway run.

Directing this play has been a pleasant and highly nostalgic experience for me as I have recalled again and again my own undergraduate years at Otterbein — those depression years in which we did a lot of plays on a shoestring in unlikely places under the leadership of our beloved "Prof." Smith. The present ties between Ohio State and Otterbein are strong ones. Professors Dodrill, Grissinger and Thayer have all trained at Ohio State and made that institution proud of their dynamic leadership in Speech and Theatre at Otterbein. The privileges of working in such a modern theatre plant as Cowan Hall and with such dedicated students and technicians as those in the present production combine to make me happy that I accepted the invitation to "come on down to Otterbein" for Homecoming, 1971

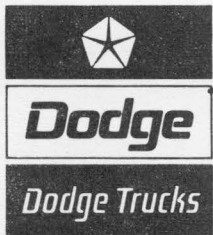

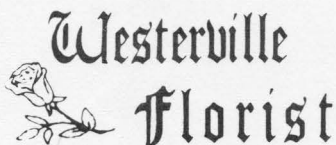
