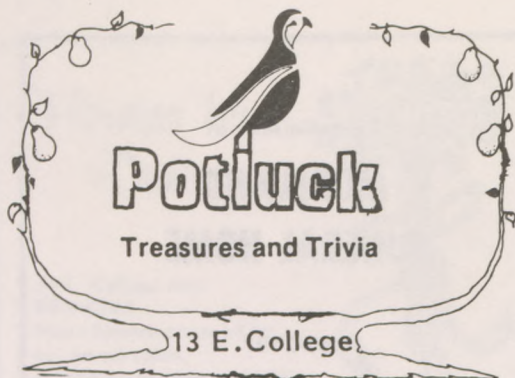

DAVE HAMMOND, a veteran of numerous Otterbein Summer Theatre seasons, will serve as technical director for the summer and will design sets for *A Thurber Carnival*, *The Elephant Man* and *God's Favorite*. Assisting him on the technical area will be Carl Wolfe. Mr. Wolfe will also design the sets for *Ten Little Indians*.

JULIE SICKLES, currently is a member of Miami University theatre faculty. Ms. Sickles will direct *A Thurber Carnival*. Ms. Sickles is a graduate of Otterbein and she holds a MFA degree from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.

GEOFFERY NELSON, is a native of Maine and is making his first directorial appearance at Otterbein Summer Theatre but Mr. Nelson is no stranger to Central Ohio audiences having directed at Weathervane Playhouse, Ohio State University and Players Theatre of Columbus. Mr. Nelson's most recent credits include: *The Importance of Being Earnest* and *Tally's Folly*.

JOANNE VANSANT, Dean of Students of Otterbein will choreograph *I Do! I Do!* Dean VanSant has been a longtime contributor to the Summer Theatre Program.
