DIRECTORS

CHARLES W. DODRILL, Director of Theatre since 1958, is a recipient of many awards, including the "Top Ten Men of the Year" award by the *Columbus Citizen-Journal* in 1967. Past president of national Theta Alpha Phi Theatre Honorary and the Ohio Theatre Alliance, he is responsible for many innovations in Otterbein Theatre, including the "guest star," summer theatre, the professional theatre intern program, and most recently the BFA degree in Theatre.

CAROL MARTY received a B.A. at Heidelberg University and went on to earn her Masters in Vocal Pedagogy at O.S.U. Carol served on the Otterbein voice faculty from 1973 to 1977 and at Capital University since 1968. An active member of the National Association of Teachers of Singing, she embellished her teaching with stage experiences with the Independent Players, where she portrayed Mother Abbess in *Sound of Music* and Rosabella in *The Most Happy Fella*.

JOANNE VAN SANT is Dean of Students at Otterbein. A native Kentuckian, she holds a B.A. degree from Denison University with an M.A. from Ohio State. She began teaching at Otterbein in 1948 and has served actively as choreographer in every musical since, including *Knickerbocker Holiday*, *The Student Prince*, *Oklahoma!*, *Brigadoon*, *Carousel*, *The Music Man*, *My Fair Lady*, *Camelot*, *Fiddler on the Roof*, *Canterbury Tales*, *Kiss Me Kate*, *Cabaret*, *Showboat* and *Applause*.

KATHLEEN LEWICKI has just completed her first year at Otterbein as an instructor, where she designed costumes for *Hedda Gabler* and *Brigadoon*, and scenery for *The Merchant of Venice* and *How the Other Half Loves*. She comes to Otterbein from her training at Carnegie-Mellon where she received an M.F.A. in Theatrical Production.

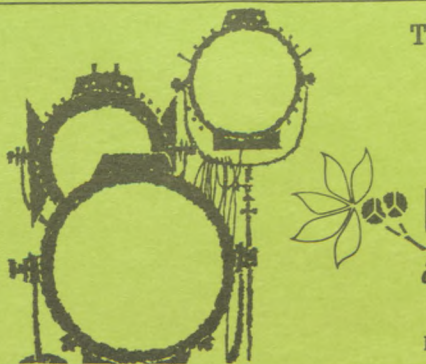

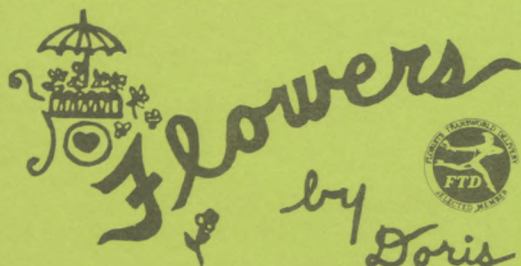

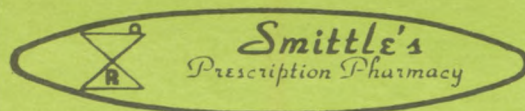
