DIRECTORS

CARTER LEWIS, a 1973 graduate of Otterbein College, has had extensive directing experience. He directed the American premiere of *Da* at Player's Theatre in Columbus, a play that has gone on to win numerous awards. At Columbus Player's Theatre, he has also directed *Relatively Speaking* and *Boys In The Band*. While at the University of Oklahoma, Carter directed *Rosencrantz and Guildenstern Are Dead*. A playwright, as well as a director, Carter has had numerous original scripts produced at various theatres.

MARY JO YEAKEL, an Otterbein senior, is a technical theatre major from Syracuse, New York. She served as Master Carpenter for the company last summer and is working in the same capacity this summer. She designed sets for last fall's production of *Robin Hood*, and will be designing this summer's production of *House of Blue Leaves* as well as *What the Butler Saw*. Mary Jo will be interning at Arena Stage in Washington D.C. starting in September.

JOHN N. DUVAL, a 1962 Otterbein graduate, returns this summer to star in *Let's Get A Divorce* and to direct *House of Blue Leaves*. He is the director of the Manatee Players in Bradenton, Florida. As a professional actor, he has played the constable in the touring company of *Zorba* and has had various major roles with the National Theatre Company, including *The Prince and The Pauper* and *Tom Sawyer*. John has directed two Off-Broadway original scripts, *Ashes* and *A Minor Miscalculation*.

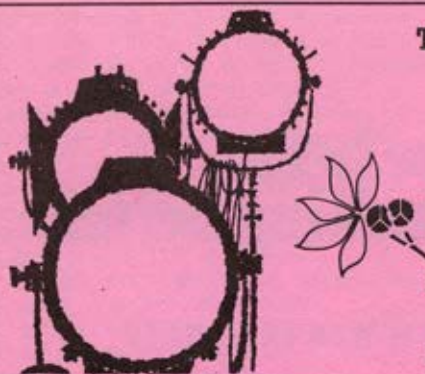

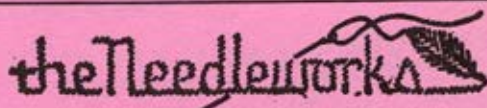
