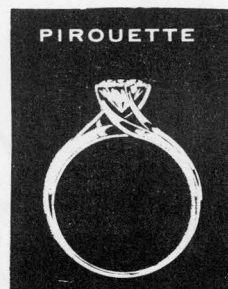

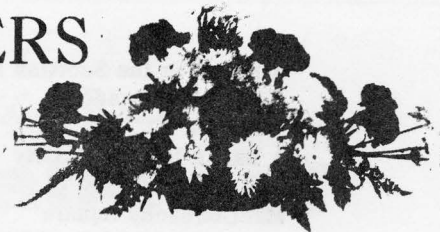

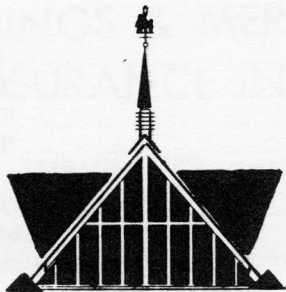

Directors

CHARLES W. DODRILL is Director of Theatre and Special Events at Otterbein. A native West Virginian, he holds an A.B. degree from Glenville State, an M.A. from the University of Kansas and a Ph.D. from Ohio State University. **Brigadoon** is the 25th production he has staged at Otterbein since he began teaching here in 1958. In addition to his theatre activities Dr. Dodrill is responsible for the Artist Series programs at Otterbein and he is currently Vice-Chairman of the Arts Council of Columbus.

ALAN BRADLEY, a native of Galesburg, Illinois, was graduated from Knox College with an A.B. degree in 1956. In 1957 he received the M.M. degree from Indiana University and is continuing work there toward the doctorate degree. Before coming to Otterbein, he was a member of the faculty at Morris Harvey College, Charleston, West Virginia. Previous musicals directed by Mr. Bradley at Otterbein include "The Pajama Game," "The Boyfriend," and "Annie Get Your Gun." Mr. Bradley is also a member of the Columbus Symphony Orchestra. At Otterbein he teaches music history, conducting, and applied music.

JOANNE VAN SANT is Dean of Students at Otterbein. A native Kentuckian, she holds an A.B. degree from Denison University and a M.A. from Ohio State University. She began teaching at Otterbein in 1948 and has served actively as choreographer or assistant choreographer in every musical since, including "Knickerbocker Holiday," "The Student Prince," "Brigadoon" in 1956, "Oklahoma," "The Pajama Game," "The Boyfriend," and "Annie Get Your Gun."

DEENA FERRIGNO received a B.A. from the University of Massachusetts, and an M.A. from the University of Michigan, where she acted as Technical Director and Designer of Children's Theatre for two years. She most recently has worked as assistant stage manager and sound technician for the American Conservatory Theatre in New York and San Francisco. We are delighted to have her with us for the second semester and summer while Prof. Fred Thayer is on sabbatical leave doing graduate work.

GLEN DAUGHERTY, Director of the Otterbein Men's and Women's Glee Clubs, is in his third year as an instructor in the Dept. of Music. A tenor, he has sung lead roles in numerous operatic and oratoria performances, including an appearance as soloist with the Louisville Orchestra. He holds a Bachelor's Degree from North Texas State, a Master's from the University of Texas and has done additional work at Ohio State. During the 1956 season he was stock tenor with the Kansas City Starlight Theatre, appearing in ten shows including "Annie," "Kismet," "King and I," "Paint Your Wagon."

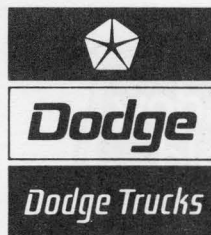
