## GUEST ARTIST

ROBERT FORSTER, star of stage, television and screen was attending the University of Rochester as a psychology major when he decided to try theatre, just to see if he could do it. After a stint with the East Rochester Summer Theatre he went to New York City where, within a year, he was cast in the two-character play *Mrs. Dally Has A Lover* starring Arlene Francis.

His career in films began with an interview with noted director John Huston, who made an instant offer. "Things happen like that," Forster recalls, snapping his fingers. "That's how they have to happen." The offer was for a major role in *Reflections in a Golden Eye* with Elizabeth Taylor and Marlon Brando. He followed this first

cinematic appearance with *Stalking Moon* with Gregory Peck and Eve Marie Saint, *Medium Cool* with Peter Boyle, *Pieces of Dreams* with Lauren Hutton, *Journey Through Rosebud* with Christopher Tabori and *The Don Is Dead* with Anthony Quinn. Two of these pictures, *Medium Cool* and *Journey Through Rosebud*, are now considered modern film classics and Forster is often invited to discuss them in college film classes.

His numerous television appearances include two series, "Banyon" and "Nakia," a TV movie "The Death Squad" with Melvin Douglas, and semi-regular guest star appearances on "Police Story." His latest TV movie was "Standing Tall," the NBC Saturday Night Movie on Jan. 21, 1978.

He appeared as guest artist in the Otterbein production of *A Streetcar Named Desire* in March of 1975, having played the role previously with Julie Harris in a 1967 road production and again in the Lincoln Center production of 1973. He starred in the 1976 production of "Cuckoo" that was an outstanding success at the Philadelphia Playhouse-in-the-Park and several other eastern cities. Another recent guest star appearance was in *The Sea Horse* at the Actors' Theatre of Louisville.
