Dear Mrs. Stauffer:

Thank you for the copy of your recent letter to the Royal Dutch Airlines official which you sent me. I appreciated it for two reasons. The first is that it helped me to keep abreast of current information in regard to our Sierra Leone program.

The second reason is even more personal. During the last few weeks, Mrs. Turner and I have been discussing the possibility of traveling with you to Sierra Leone. We have always been interested in the country but have never been there. If Otterbein College is going to explore the possibilities of an exchange program with Fourah Bay College or develop mutual interests in any direction, it might be a good idea for me to talk to some of the educators and officials in that country.

We would pay our own expenses, of course, and would remain in Sierra Leone only for a week or so -- not the whole winter term. I would appreciate it, if, in your future conversations with the airline, the authorities, etc., you would mention this possibility and find out whether it would be feasible.
