Dr. Batross received a Master of Science in Nursing from Otterbein in 2004 and a Doctor of Nursing Practice in 2016. Her DNP research was on the evaluation of quality of life in heart failure patients with low health literacy levels. She found an almost 50 percent health literacy rate in her local community. "The challenge was in educating these patients in a very complicated treatment regimen. My philosophy on education is to start with what students know and build on their current knowledge," she stated. Her hobbies include cooking and photography and "I love my dogs," she added.
