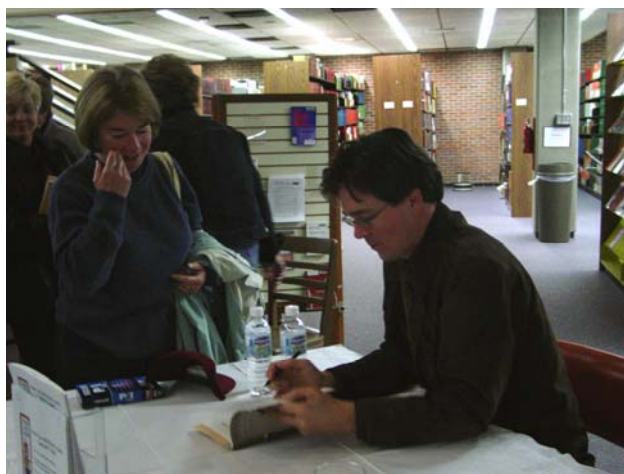

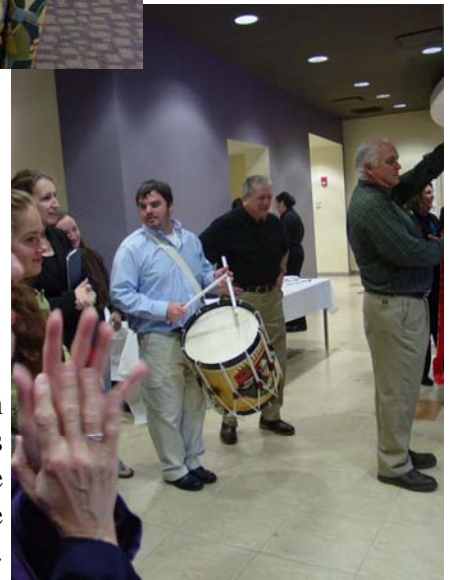

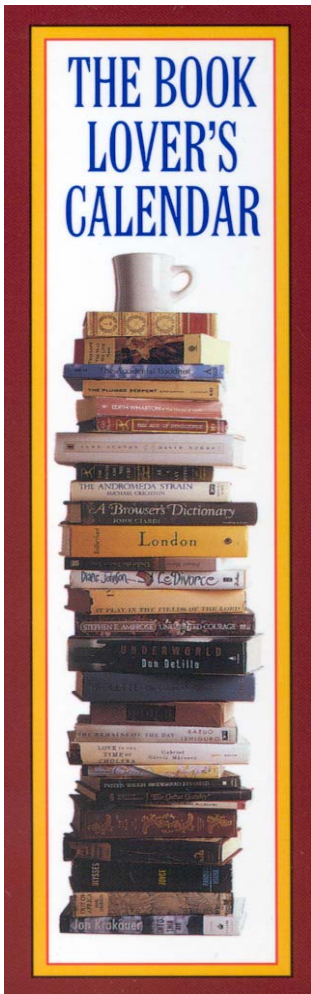
The second book will be *Skipping Christmas*, by John Grisholm. The meeting for this book will be held on Monday, January 3 at 7:30 in the same room.
