She has served six terms as board president, three terms as vice president, and acted as board liaison in areas such as policy, strategic planning, curriculum and instruction, personnel, governmental relations, facilities and business operations, and communications. She has provided strategic leadership for more than 30 ballot campaigns related to the schools and the Board of Education.

Nancy's community involvement includes current board positions with the Ohio Crime Victims Justice Center, Neighborhood Bridges, Uptown Westerville, Inc, Academy Selection Board for the Office of Congressman Troy Balderson, and the Central College Presbyterian Church. Among many other boards and committees, Nancy previously served on the Franklin County Family and Children First Council, Building Better Lives Council, Southern Gateway Revitalization Committee, Columbus Higher Education Partnership, the Association of NROTC Colleges and Universities, and the Ohio State Outreach and Engagement Steering Committee, and the Ohio Teacher of the Year Selection Committee.
