



The first Agatha Christie mystery we've produced since 1989's *The Unexpected Guest, Black Coffee* is a little-known mystery that should surprise and delight all Christie fans. The story concerns a physicist named Sir Claude Amory who has come up with a formula for an atom bomb (*Black Coffee* was written in 1934!). In the first act, Sir Claude is poisoned (in his coffee, naturally)—and Christie's famed detective Hercule Poirot is called in to save the case.
