Otterbein, seeking to turn the corner before the new millennium, opens the 1999 season this evening with the College of Mount St. Joseph Lions.

The Cardinals—just missing the .500 mark in 1998—head into the new season with four solid classes as head coach Wally Hood begins his fifth season with Otterbein.

"This is the most experienced team we've had since I've been here," Hood says. "Based on our finish last year, how we played competitively, the expectations of our players are higher than they have ever been."

Among the many goals set for this season is "record the best record this school has had in 17 years," Hood says. That was 1982 when Otterbein, under coach Rich Seils, went 5-4, capping off four consecutive seasons of winning football.

The Lions, under seventh-year head coach Ron Corradini, come into the game fresh off a 35-13 win over Olivet (MI) in their season opener at home last Saturday.

Mt. Saint Joseph, led by junior quarterback Mark Schorsch, employed a balanced attack, rolling up 411 yards of offense against Olivet—198 yards by air and 213 on the ground.

Schorsch scored three times on the ground with runs of one, one and four yards. He completed ten of 16 passes for 119 yards. Junior running back Doug Anderson rolled up 114 rushing yards, including one of 72 for a touchdown.

Following Mt. Saint Joseph, Otterbein opens Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) play at home, hosting Baldwin-Wallace, 6:30 p.m., Saturday.

Cardinal Notes

Last Meeting: Otterbein and Mt. Saint Joseph met for the first time in 1998 with the Cardinals coming out on top, 24-0, in Cincinnati. Otterbein quarterback Matt D'Orazio completed 13 of 22 pass attempts for 225 yards and two touchdowns.

Ailiff & D'Orazio Named Captains: Senior inside linebacker Roger Ailiff and senior D'Orazio were selected by teammates to captain the 1999 squad. Ailiff, who tallied 100 tackles in 1998, was selected first team All-OAC. D'Orazio, an honorable mention All-OAC pick last season, holds three Otterbein single-season passing records.

Experience: Otterbein returns 41 lettermen, including nine starters each on offense and defense. Junior punter and place-kicker Brett Dorsett, selected second team All-OAC in 1998, returns. Twelve seniors are expected to start this evening.

New Faces in Starting Lineup: Junior Greg Curry gets the nod at left tackle, and junior David Anon at fullback. New-comers on defense include sophomore Andre' Mock, a transfer from the University of Toledo, at defensive end; freshman Michael Moss at strong safety; and sophomore Seth Watson at free safety. Moss is filling in for junior starter Mike Mancuso, who is out with an injury.

Home Cooking: In addition to Mt. Saint Joseph and Baldwin-Wallace, Otterbein faces cross-town rival Capital, Heidelberg and Hiram at home this season.

Tough Road Schedule: Otterbein plays John Carroll, Muskingum, Mount Union, Ohio Northern and Marietta on the road. The conference coaches picked three-time defending national champion Mount Union, Ohio Northern and John Carroll to finish one, two and three in the OAC this season. Otterbein was picked to finish seventh, behind Baldwin-Wallace (4th), Muskingum (5th) and Marietta (6th).

CARDINAL MARCHING BAND

The Cardinal Marching Band continues its tradition of highlighting halftime with hand-clapping, toe-tapping music for football fans of all ages. Besides its popular football game performances, the band also performs in local parades and at special functions. To add to these performances, the band provides music for front groups, including the O-Squad (dance), the Cardinal Guard (flags), and solo featured twirlers.

One of the outside functions the band is noted for is the annual Circleville Pumpkin Show. The band also performs at local high school band concerts, including St. Francis DeSales High School. This program is designed to interest high school students in becoming involved with marching band in college.

The Cardinal Marching Band also has a very active alumni following. Alumni band members often join the band in celebrating Homecoming.

Senior Drum Major Carl Gelfius, First Assistant Andrew Peters and Second Assistant Mandi Wilson will lead the Cardinal Marching Band onto the field this year. The 1999 band is under the direction of band directors Dr. Jeffrey D. Boehm '82 and Mr. John Orr '79. The Cardinal Guard and O-Squad advisor is Susie Crum '86.

Membership in the band is open to all students of Otterbein College, regardless of their majors. Of the approximately 100 members, one-third are music majors and the other two-thirds come from other areas of the college.

This season's musical selections are taken from a variety of genre, including Rock, Jazz, Classical and Show tunes.



Dr. Jeffrey D. Boehm '82 is beginning his third year as Director of the Otterbein Cardinal Marching Band. Dr. Boehm came to Westerville after having taught for three years at William Penn College in Oskaloosa, Iowa. He received his Ph.D. in

Music Education and his M.M. in Trumpet Performance from the University of Wisconsin, Madison, and his B.M.E. from Otterbein College in 1982. Dr. Boehm has 12 years of public and private school teaching experience, having taught all levels of band in Westerville, OH; Milton, WV; Madison, WI; and Oskaloosa, IA. He also was the drill coordinator and a horn-line instructor with the Capitol Aires Drum and Bugle Corps from Madison, WI. Dr. Boehm is an active trumpet player, and has formed a chamber duo with his wife, Kim, called the Boehm System.

John W. Orr '79 is serving in his fourth year as Assistant Director of the Cardinal Marching Band. An Otterbein alumnus, John is married to Denise (Alford), a fellow member of the Class of 1979. Both John and Denise were in the Cardinal Marching Band for four years under the direction of Professor Gary Tirey. In addition to receiving bachelor's degrees in Music Education and B.S. in Elementary Education from Otterbein, John holds a Master of Educational Administration. John's marching band experience includes work with the high school bands in Dublin and Pickerington, as well as 16 years assisting with the Independence High School Band in the Columbus Public Schools.

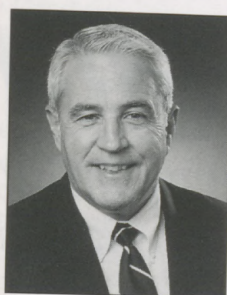
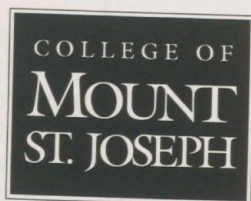

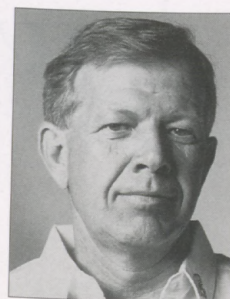
