Alice J. Cornell } know all men by these presents that  
is } Alice J. Cornell, of the City of Columbus of the  
C W Miller } County of Franklin and State of Ohio, in  
consideration of the sum of Twenty three hundred dollars to her paid  
by C. W. Miller of the county of Franklin and State of Ohio, the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant bargain sell and  
convey to the said C. W. Miller, and unto his heirs and assigns  
forever the following real estate situated in the county of Franklin  
in the State of Ohio and in the Township of Blendon and  
bounded and described as follows, situated in Range seventeen  
(17) Section two (2) Township two (2) U. S. Military Land com-  
mencing in the center of the State Road on the south line of  
the farm formerly owned by John Bishop thence west on  
said line to the center of Elm Creek, thence north with said Creek  
to the center of the said Bishop farm and the south line of the land  
formerly owned by Paul Wimbough, thence East parallel with the  
south line of said land to the center of the said State Road, then  
south with said Road to the place of beginning containing Four  
three acres and ninety two and a half rods of land more or  
less, but excepting from said land and boundaries four acres  
from the north east corner thereof and being the same land conveyed  
by Angeline C. Cornell to John Dodds dated the 15 day of No-  
vember A.D. 1854, - the land now conveyed being the same devised  
to said Alice J. Cornell by the will of the said Angeline C. Cornell  
dated on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1844, and released and con-  
veyed by John B. Cornell - the brother of the said Alice  
J. Cornell and the only other heir at law of said Angeline  
C. Cornell to said Alice J. Cornell by deed dated August 24<sup>th</sup>  
1869 to have and to hold said premises with all the priviley  
and appurtenances therunto belonging to the said C. W. Miller  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever and the said  
Alice J. Cornell for herself and her heirs does hereby  
convey and with the said C. W. Miller and his heirs

and assigns that she is lawfully seized of the premises of  
said tract - The said premises are free and clear from all  
incumbrances whatsoever and that she will forever warrant  
and defend the same with the appurtenances unto the said  
C W Miller and unto his heirs and assigns against the  
lawful claims of all persons whomsoever,
