Some seats still remain for performances tonight and Friday and Saturday nights of the Tony Award-winning musical "Applause," produced by Otterbein College Theater, the Otterbein Department of Music, and the dance area. All three performances begin at 8:15 p.m. in Cowan Hall.

Reduced-rate tickets still are available to students and senior citizens for tonight's performance.

The hit musical, based on the 1950 Bette Davis movie "All About Eve," features delightful songs and dances, including the title number "Applause, Applause," as well as "Welcome to the Theater," "Fasten Your Seat Belts," and "One of a Kind."

The story revolves around show business and gives a backstage glimpse into the struggle of a promising up-and-coming actress to depose a reigning star—by hook or crook.
