Otterbein Outcomes

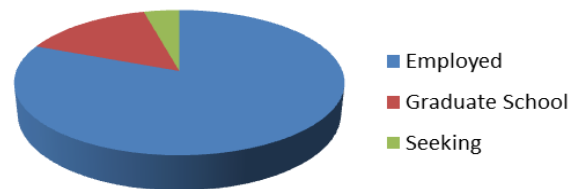
Of the 498 degrees awarded between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2015, information was obtained on 368 graduates for a knowledge rate of 73.89%. Within six months of graduation, the following outcomes were obtained: **Employed: 80.97%**

Graduate School: 14.94%

Seeking: 4.06%
