Hiram In Win Over Otterbein

A third period touchdown enabled Hiram to come from behind to gain a 12-7 victory over Otterbein in the annual homecoming at the Westerville school Saturday afternoon.

A sustained drive of 80 yards following the second half kick-off was climaxed when Al Hrabak crashed over from the four. It took the visitors eight minutes and 15 seconds for this scoring drive.

Hiram opened the scoring when Bob Stochl went over from the four after a fumble was recovered on the Otter 14. It took only two plays to go over. Ed Crowley, Hiram end, received the fumble.

The Otterbein scored came seven plays after a punt was returned to the Hiram 19 by Eric Dowell with 3:36 remaining in the second period, with a 3-yard pass from Mel Staats to John Magaw scoring. John Magaw added the extra point by placement.

Otterbein now has a 3-2 record for all games and 2-2 in the Ohio Conference.

Fumbles proved costly to the Otters.

Hiram was halted on the Otterbein 13 late in the fourth period.

Hiram led in first downs, 16-7. On the ground, the winners gained 192 to 112 for the host team. In the air, Hiram had the edge with 69 yards on six of 18 tries. The Otters had six of 15 for 41 yards.
