## Otterbein sets stage with comedy, drama

Otterbein College will offer classic American plays and musicals next season, beginning with *Babes in Arms*, Rodgers and Hart's musical comedy about summer-stock theater.

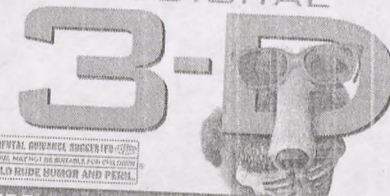
