Otterbein's Canadians Lace Hiram

Otterbein's Canadian trio, Norm Lukey, Doug Thomson and Pete Parker led the Cardinals to a 49-28 homecoming football victory over Hiram Saturday afternoon in Memorial Stadium on the Westerville campus.

Thomson, a 5-1, 205-pound sophomore, scored three touchdowns and churned 192 yards in 29 carries. His fellow townsman from Oakville, Ontario, Pete Parker, caught a pair of touchdown passes from Norm Lukey, the veteran Otter quarterback from Toronto.

IT WAS Otterbein's initial win of the season in five games and put its Ohio Conference mark at 1-3. The losing Terriers stand 1-3 in the league and for the season.

A pair of Terrier mistakes at the outset of the game opened the floodgates for the Otterbein victory. Otterbein recovered a Hiram fumble on the Terrier 38 and seven plays later Thomson scored his first TD from the four.

On the next Hiram series a pass interception turned the ball over to the Cardinals and Tevor Newland tallied from the three. Newland also booted six conversions.

THE GAME was an offensive show all the way as Otterbein rolled up 523 yards rushing and passing and Hiram 444. Lukey completed 12 of 21 aerials for 205 yards.

Otterbein counted 25 first downs to 12 for Hiram.
