Big Ten's Spotlight On Illinois

CHICAGO (AP) — The Big Ten football title chase, barely off the ground, is coming to a boil upusually early—and most of the fire comes from Saturday's Northwestern-Illinois game.

In the only other conference encounter, Ohio State invades Indiana.

The championship campaign was sprung last week when Northwestern repelled Indiana 34-21.

THE WEEKEND schedule opens Friday night with Michigan State facing Southern California's eighth ranked Trojans in the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum.

Rounding out Saturday's card, Iowa is at Washington, Navy at Michigan, Army at Minnesota and Notre Dame at Purdue. Wisconsin, edging Notre Dame 14-9 last week, has an off day.

Only Purdue's 3-0 loss to Miami of Florida and Minnesota's 14-7 defeat by Nebraska mar the Big Ten's interseasonal traffic so far. Iowa and Washington State battled to a 14-14 deadlock.

BUT THE ODDSMAKERS think the Big Ten is in for a more shaky weekend this time. They have made underdogs of Purdue, Michigan,

The Muskies, losers to Akron and winners over Marietta, will be undermanned, too. Defensive end Bob Martin is suffering from a foot infection and halfback Chuck Walker, is also on the infirmary roll.

Heidelberg faces defending champ Wittenberg in a night tilt at Tiffin. The Princes will be without starters Renn Olsen, a linebacker, and halfback Tom Buchanan.

Wooster's after-dark engagement at Mt. Union rounds out the OC slate.
