Yeomen Hit Early, Sink Otters, 27-14

Oberlin College proved to be a first half team, but that alone was enough for the Yeomen to sink Otterbein, 27-14, Saturday afternoon at Westerville.

Two quick first quarter touchdowns by Hal Furcron took the punch out of favored Otterbein and spurred the Yeomen to a season-opening victory.

The Otters, beaten by Morris Harvey last week, regained some spark near the end of the quarter when Gahanna's Larry Lintner broke loose for 47 yards and the Cardinals' first score. Dick Ruh converted and Otterbein trailed, 13-7.

The second half saw Otterbein control the ball but with little success. With eight minutes gone in the final period, Otterbein's Graham Thompson finished off a 68-yard march with a plunge from one foot out. Thompson also converted for the final 27-14 tally.

On paper, Otterbein fared bet-

ter, leading in first downs, 13-11; and completing 8 of 20 passes as compared to 2 completions in 4 attempts for Oberlin. The losers gained 98 yards in the air, against 37 for Oberlin.
