Otterbein Still Atop Ohio Heap

Otterbein continued as the state's lone unbeaten and untied team by knocking off Marietta's Pioneers 46-13 — but Muskingum is the Cardinal foe this week as the going gets rougher.

Biggest surprise on the Ohio College scene was the 53-7 Denison win over Capital, first loss for the Lutherans.

Miami's Redskins lost 37-6 to Purdue, and Marshall took advantage of the fact by easing into the mid-American conference lead by whipping Ohio University 34-28. Miami gets a chance this week to tie up the top spot again by going against defending champion Bowling Green, while Marshall meets Xavier in a non-loop fray.

BLUFFTON'S Beavers completed a clean sweep of the five mid-Ohio league foes by tripping Findlay 27-13. That wrapped up a second straight league title for the Beavers, as Elbert DuBenion, former South High athlete, scored two of Bluffton's four touchdowns, one on a 74-yard pass play and another on a 73-yard run.
