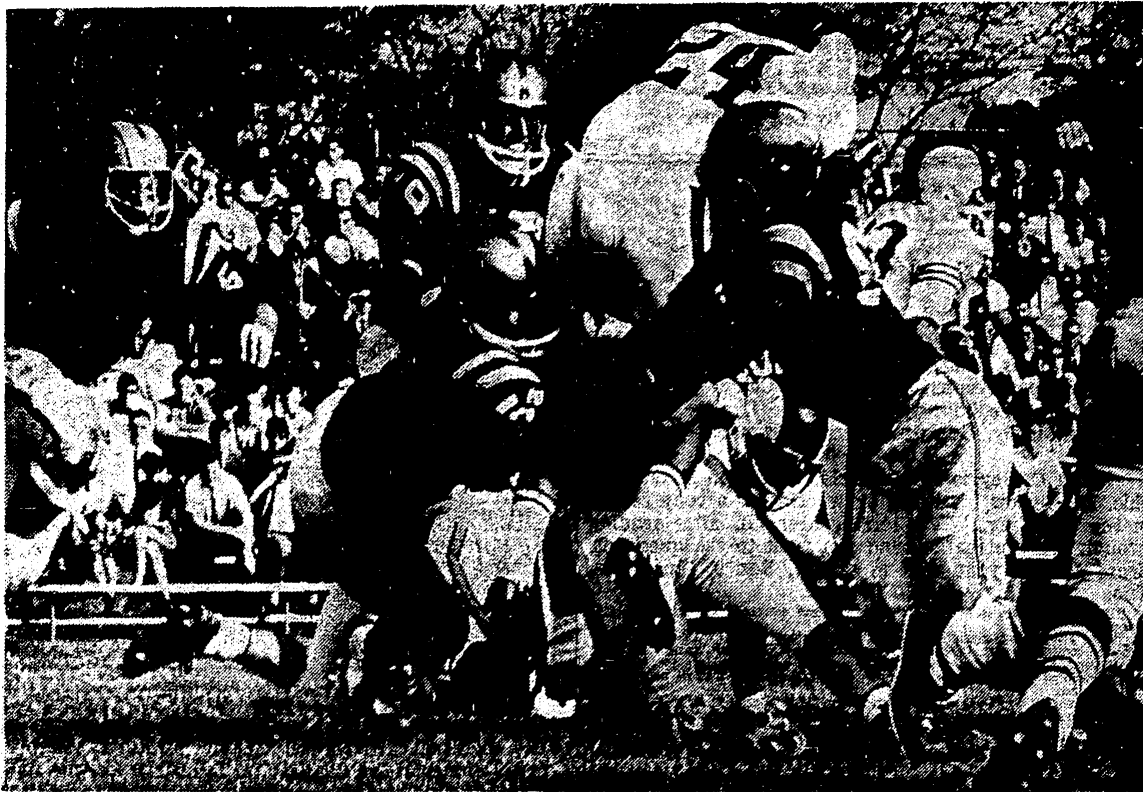
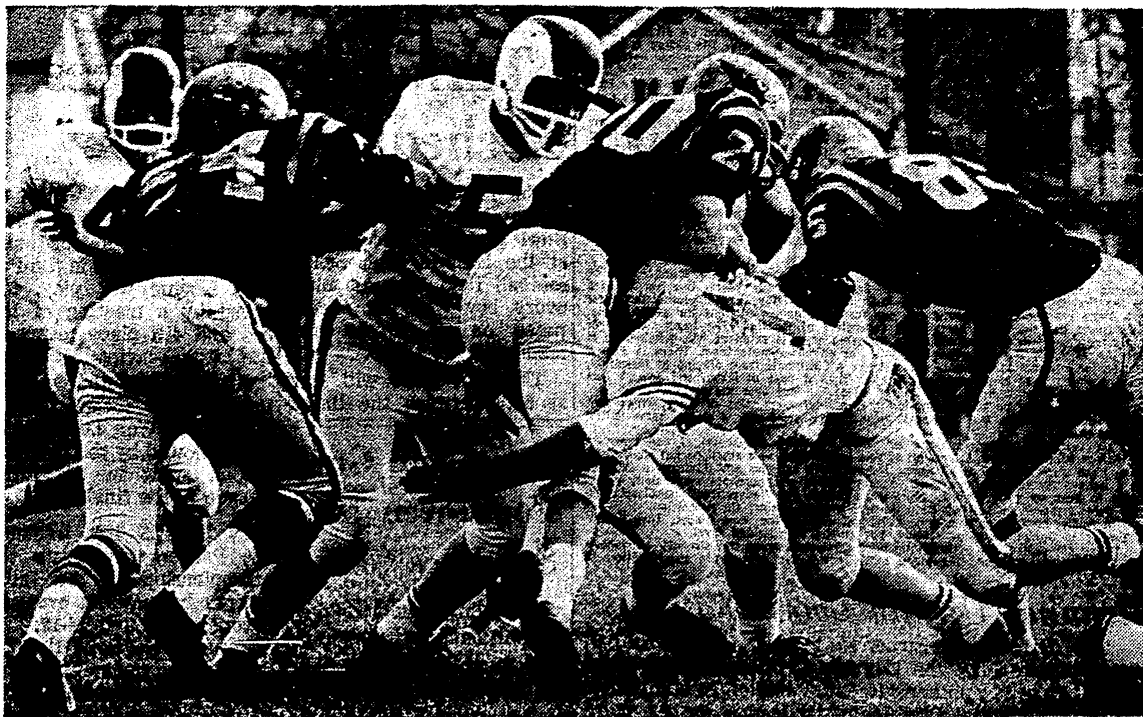

ball, was held on his own 23-yard line in an off tackle attempt in the second period. Marietta won 14 to 0.



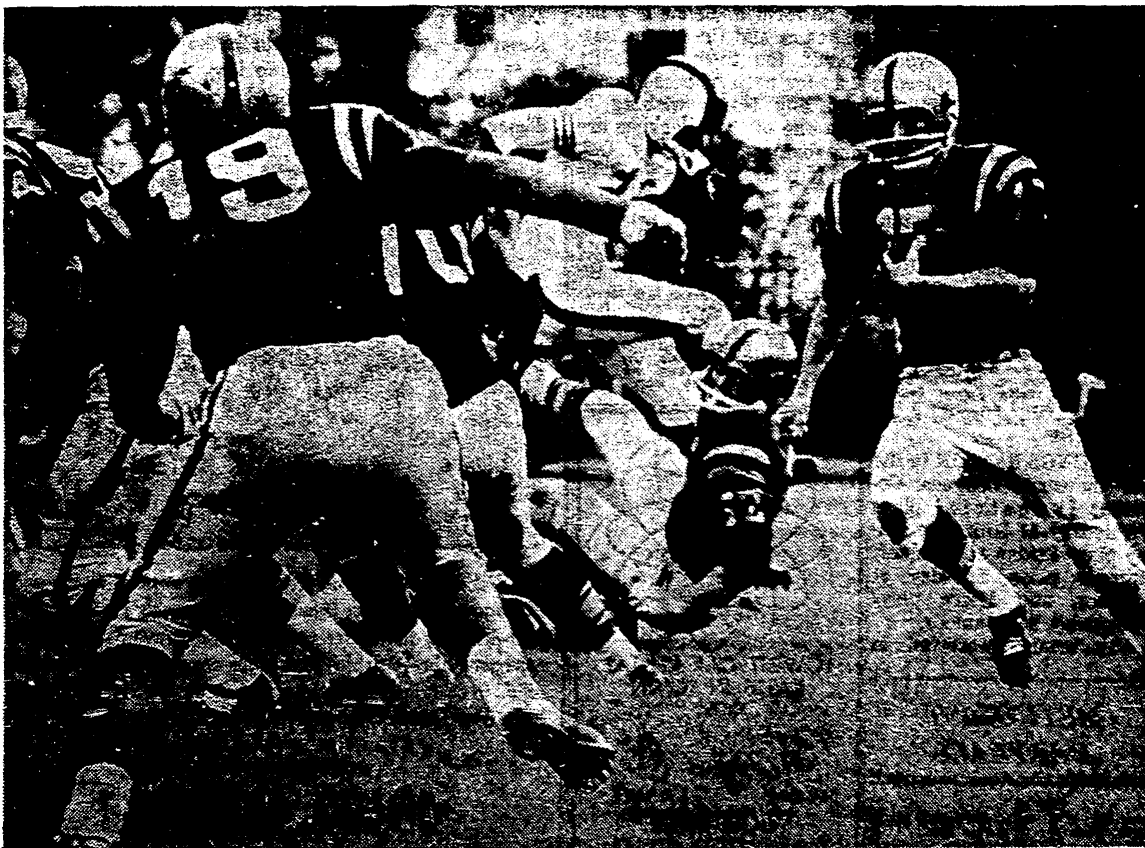
**GARY REYNOLDS GAINS THREE**—Gary Reynolds carrying the ball for Otterbein gained three yards on
