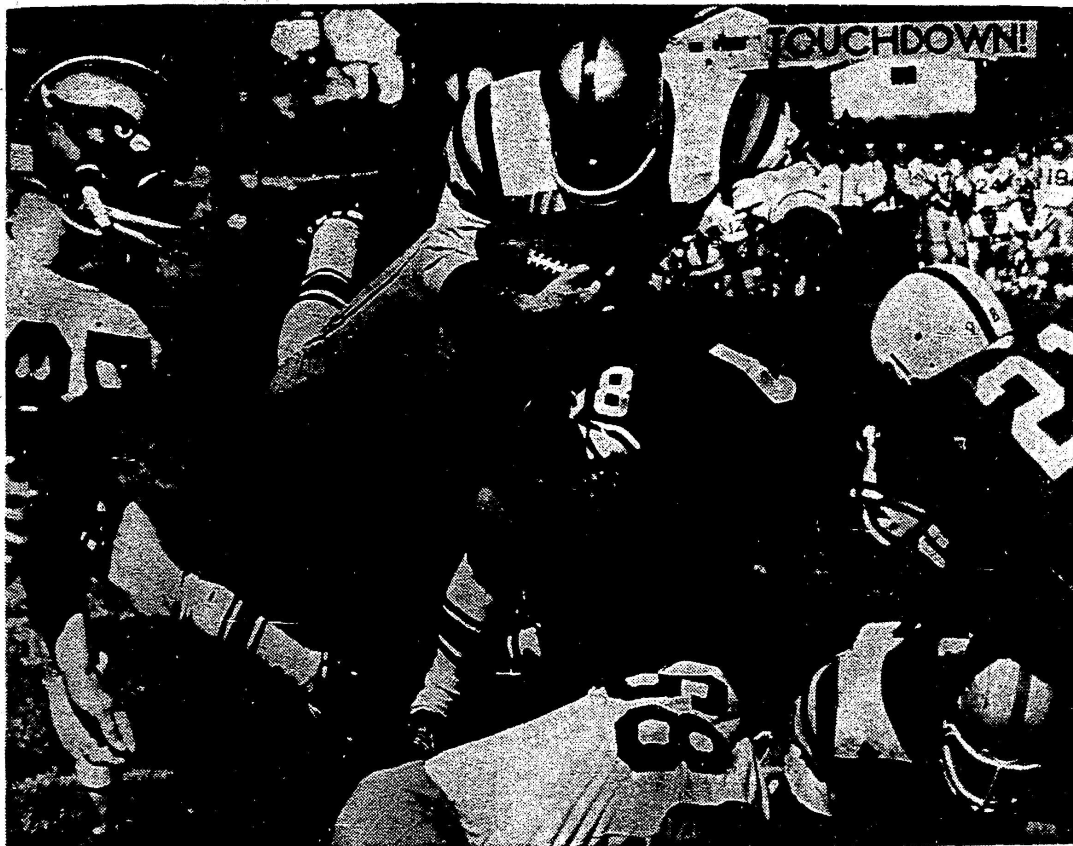

## NEW TD PASS PLAY MARK SET

# Otterbein Tramples Kenyon's Lords 42-2

**GAMBIER, Ohio** — Otterbein scored almost at will Saturday as they trampled Kenyon's Lords by a 42-2 score in an Ohio Conference grid game, played in shirt-sleeve weather before 2500 fans in McBride Stadium here.

Bill Thompson rambled for three TDs on plunges of 1-yard each, Gary Reynolds scampered 59 yards for a score, Tim Kinnison counted on a 22-yard pass from Harry Klockner, and the other Otterbein touchdown was a pass from Dave Kull to Gary Reynolds that covered 93 yards.

**THE KULL** to Reynolds effort established a new touchdown pass play record for the

Ohio Conference. The previous record was a play that covered 91. That was set by Ohio Wesleyan in 1949.

Although swamped by the final score Kenyon managed to account for 17 first downs compared to 14 for the winners.

**THE LORDS GAINED** 81 yards on the ground to 166 for Otterbein and clicked on 12 of 21 passes for 137 to Otterbein's 233 through the

air on 12 completions in 18 attempts.

Reynolds, the London halfback, led the Otterbein individual list with 131 yards in 13 carries.

**KENYON, WITH AN 0-2-0** record, all in conference play, meets Wilmington here next Saturday in a homecoming game.

The win gave Otterbein a 2-0-1 record overall and 1-0-1 in the conference.
