# Otters Host Denison In Night Clash

Denison and Otterbein, a couple of Ohio Conference teams who have been bounced around a bit this fall, meet at 8 p.m. Saturday in Memorial Stadium on the Otterbein College campus.

The OC's leading rusher and its top passer will be on display as Denison — victorious only once in five conference starts — puts its 3-4 record on the line against an Otterbein team that has a 2-3 OC record included in its 2-5 season standing.

Denison's Ed Exler, the conference top rusher, has carried 143 times for 780 yards, a 5.4 yards-per-carry average. Otter quarterback Norm Lukey, who will be playing in his final home game, is 89 of 136 for 1301 yards and four touchdowns in the passing department.

The Parents' Night game finds Otterbein looking for its first win over Denison since 1946. The teams have met seven times since and the best Otter finish was a 20-20 tie in 1951.

Denison has a 25-10-2 series advantage and was a 36-21 victor a year ago. That one was also played in Westerville's Memorial Stadium.
