PRODUCTION *YOU'RE A GOOD MAN, CHARLIE BROWN*

The classic comic strip characters everyone can relate to come to the Otterbein stage as the annual Children's Theatre Production presents *You're a Good Man Charlie Brown* (1999 Revised Version) from Nov. 10-13 in Cowan Hall, 30 S. Grove St., Westerville.

Based on the ever-popular *Peanuts* comic strip by Charles M. Schulz, *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown* shows an average day in the life of Charlie Brown — a day made up of little moments picked from all the days of Charlie Brown, from Valentine's Day to the baseball season, from wild optimism to utter despair, all mixed up with the lives of his friends (both human and non-human) and strung together on the string of a single day, from bright, uncertain morning to hopeful, starlit evening.

The production is based on the book, music and lyrics of Clark Gesner; additional dialogue by Michael Mayer; and additional music and lyrics by Andrew Lippa. It will be guest directed by Valerie Accetta Thalassinos, Otterbein Class of 2004, and choreographed by Stella Hiatt Kane.

The opening night performance on Thursday, Nov. 10, begins at 7:30 p.m. The Sunday, Nov. 13, matinee begins at 2 p.m. All other performances begin at 8 p.m.
