
Fraaternities Pledge 55 Men at Otterbein

More than half of the freshman at Otterbein college went to the fraternity house of their choice after 9 o'clock Wednesday night signifying acceptance of pledges offered between Saturday and 6 p. m., Wednesday. Mack Grimes of Piqua, president of the Interfraternity council, announced Thursday that the five fraternities had pledged a total of 55 men of the 104 registered. Several others are expected to join over the week-end, which is homecoming at Otterbein.

Zeta Phi, which is observing its 25th anniversary at homecoming, pledged 22 freshmen, the largest group on the campus. Pi Kappa Phi was next with 15, followed by Sigma Delta Phi with 10. Pi Beta Sigma, five, and Eta Phi Mu, three.

Rushing for Otterbein freshmen women starts the first of next month with pledging the day before the Thanksgiving vacation starts.
