Eagles Nudge Otterbein, 7-6

Zen Chawanski's perfect placement provided Ashland with its margin for a 7-6 victory over Otterbein Saturday night in the Otters' Memorial Stadium.

It was the sixth win in seven starts for the Eagles who have already won the Mid-Ohio Conference championship. The defeat set Otterbein's season record at 3-3-1.

After a stalemated first half, Ashland scored with 8:58 remaining in the third period. The 73-yard drive, which included a 36-yard aerial from Dick Geitgey to Ed Knittle, was capped by Geitgey's 14-yard pitch to Gene French. Chawanski converted.

A 17-YARD Ashland punt gave Otterbein the ball on its 38 late in the final period. The Cardinals' overland march was led by Bill Thompson and Gary Reynolds. Dave Kull hit Dick Morrow twice and Ray Leffler once in the push that carried to the Eagles' 2. Gary Reynolds pumped in for the TD.

Kull's attempt for the two-point conversion failed when his pass overshot the target.
