Capital's Top Gainer Is Out

Capital University took a load of bad news Wednesday when it became definite Bruce McGinnis would not be able to play any more this season because of a knee injury received Saturday.

This was a jolt to the Caps who have been working hard this week in hopes to winning the Otterbein game this week—a game which makes a success out of an otherwise poor season, for either team.

And there's no possibility of rating this game on a comparative score chart. The two Capital wins were over teams which beat Otterbein (Wilmington and Marietta), and the two Otterbein victories have been over teams (Hiram and Kenyon) which tripped Capital.

Jerry Johnson, former West High School quarterback, who has been looking good as a fullback this season, will carry the brunt of the Capital offensive load. Johnson has averaged 4.9 yards in 54 carries and has been the leading ground gainer. He moved to the fullback spot when Roy Gruenburg received an ankle injury.
