

Otters Close Season With Adrian Game

Otterhein will close the books Saturday on one of the most dismal football seasons in its history and the worst since 1939. That was the year when the Cardinals went down to defeat in all eight games, while scoring a single touchdown.

In their season's finale, the Otters will be host to Adrian College of Michigan. It will be the first meeting of the two schools.

In eight games played so far this season the Cards have dropped six while winning from Indiana Central and playing a tie game with Ashland.

In Adrian, the Cards will be facing a team which has won half of its games. In its last outing, Adrian took a 6-0 decision from Ferris Institute.

Saturday's contest will be last for four Otter regulars: Ro Mehl, Junior Miller, Jim Wallace and Bert Bailey. Mehl, Miller and Bailey are winding up their fourth season with the Cards, and Wallace his third.
