# Several Freshmen In Otter Lineup

Harry Ewing, Otterbein's coach, who is getting his boys ready for their home opener Saturday against Ohio Wesleyan, has finally landed on a system of offensive play for the season.

Ewing annually tries to fit the offense to suit the boys, and not announce two months previously that he will play the so-and-so system and then try to fit the boys to it.

So, he's figured out the offense for the year—and, of all things, it'll be a combination. The Otters will use a T, the single wing, and the short punt. "You can do anything from that short punt," Ewing claims.

But even now Coach Ewing isn't certain of his starting lineup. "We've several boys who are about on a par with each other and it'll take a couple of more days for me to decide."

But he's leaning toward freshman halfbacks, Larry Lintner of Gahanna and Dave Wade of Cambridge; Dick Ruh and Dick Brockett will probably play end, with Ruh going in for punting; Earl Blecher and Gahanna's 225-pound frosh, Bob White, will be tackles; at guard will be two lettermen, Ed Axline and Ned Forman, with Glen Miller at center.

Dick Richter of Dayton or Dublin's Ronald Smith will be signal callers. Pete Fields of

Worthington and Bob Fowler of Canal Winchester will alternate at fullback. He also plans on using John Underwood of Dublin and Frank Mione, a letterman, in the backfield.
