

Otterbein Beats Crusaders 13-7

Sophomore quarterback Bill Hillier ran for 102 yards and passed for 122 more Saturday night to lead Otterbein College to a 13-7 football victory over arch rival Capital in Memorial Stadium at Westerville.

Placekicking specialist Maurizio Schindler added a pair of field goals and one conversion as the Otters, now 3-0 for the season, ended a string of 11 Capital victories in the long series.

The visiting Crusaders fumbled six times and lost three of the miscues in losing for the second time in three starts.

A 25-yard Maurizio Schindler field goal with 11:08 remaining in the first period gave the Otters a 3-0 lead, which was increased to 10-0 with 5:01 left in the opening session on a 44-yard TD jaunt by quarterback Bill Hillier.

BOB TALPAS' recovery of a Jim Wlnans fumble at the Cap 37 gave the Otters possession and Schindler's FG came after a Cardinal advance stalled at the Cap 8.

Hillier swept left end on his TD run after teammate Abe Hatem intercepted a Steve Gwin aerial at the
