

Capital Whips Otters In Season Finale 35-20

Capital University's Crusaders downed arch rival Otterbein, 35-20, Saturday night in Memorial Stadium on the Otter campus in the season finale for both teams. The result left both teams with identical 2-4 Ohio Conference and 3-6 overall records.

SENIOR HALFBACK Colby Byrom, who reinjured his ankle in the fourth period, carried 16 times for 111 yards and two touchdowns, and quarterback Charlie Hess got 91 on 15 rushing

attempts. Fullback Geoff Schmidt added 76 in 16 cracks.

Otterbein closed it to 21-12 early in the third period on Sam Varney's 27-yard return for a TD after intercepting a Hess aerial.

Byrom's second TD from three yards out capped a 71-yard march for a 28-12 Cap advantage with seven minutes left in the same session and linebacker Les Ritter picked off a Greg Miller bobble and returned it 37 yards for the winners' final tally with 6:30 to go in the third quarter.

Wayne Blevins ran 14 yards for Otterbein's final score in the first minute of the final period following an
