

Weather May Catch Ohio College Clubs

Ohio college football players may find more than a hint of snow in the air when they take to their respective fields Saturday.

The weather bureau forecasts a few snow flurries for Ohio.

Three mid-American contests are booked in Ohio, with five in the Ohio Conference, one in the mid-Ohio and a group of interesting clashes.

In the mid-American, Miami, rated virtually, a sure thing to win the title, plays Western Michigan. Ohio University, knocked out of the running by Miami last week, goes to Boston to meet a tough Harvard eleven. The Harvards line is considered the Crimson's best in five years.

Other mid-American games take Bowling Green to Kent State and Marshall to Western Reserve.

Muskingum comes to Capital in a game that will help decide the Ohio Conference championship. Also in the Ohio Conference are Denison against Wittenberg, Wooster-Akron, Mount Union-Ohio Wesleyan and Hiram-Otterbein.
