# Cap Punter Has 'Kick'

"No justice" might well be the cry of Capital University's expert punter, Judd Hall, to express his sentiments about the current Ohio Conference punting race. Despite having the best punting average in the Buckeye loop, Judd is not likely to win the kicking race.

Why? Thus far this season his teammates have shown an aggressive offense which has usually managed to just move Capital far enough out its own backyard to eliminate the necessity of punting. This, together with the complications of the single platoon system, has tended to keep punts at a minimum. And what can a single punter do when he can't get a chance to punt?

In seven games Judd, a senior, has booted the pigskin only 13 times, a total of 526 yards. This figures out to a 40.5-yard average—five yards per try above the next Ohio Conference punter.

Judd's "kick" comes from the fact that Conference statistics are figured on no less than two punts a game average. So, in Capital's season finale at Otterbein this Saturday Judd will have to punt three times to qualify the booter's crown.
