Otterbein Winner Over Adrian, 28-13

Flashing their best form of the year, Otterbein's Cardinals closed out their 1948 season at Westerville Saturday with a 28-13 victory over the Adrian College Bulldogs.

Scoring once in each quarter, the Cards enjoyed the upper hand throughout the contest. Sparking the Otter offensive were Bert Bailey, speedy little halfback from Middletown who was playing his last game for the Cards, and Don Smith, Dayton fullback. Each racked up two touchdowns and

period on a razzle dazzle play. Long passed from the Adrian 28 to Clark on the 10, who lateralled to Bailey. The latter going over for the score.

Adrian's second touchdown came a few minutes later when Maynard Clark skirted left end for 12 yards to score, after the Michigan school had rolled to four straight first downs.

With a minute remaining in the game, Bob Gillis of Adrian was tackled behind his own goal line to give the Otters a safety and two extra points.

Saturday's victory gave Otterbein a season's record identical with that of last year, two wins, six defeats and one tie. Adrian completed its season with five wins in nine starts.

Otterbein's first score came on a 35-yard march with Bailey scampering 13 yards for a touchdown after taking a hand-off from Bobby Long.

65-Yard Run

A 27-yard pass from Kenny Zarbaugh to Long put the ball on the Adrian 1-yard stripe as the first period ended. On the second play of the second quarter Smith plowed over for the score.

Adrian scored its first touchdown late in the same quarter on a 65-yard run by Babe Schultz, Bulldog fullback. The visitors threatened again early in the third period, but lost the ball on downs on the 8-yard line.

The Cardinals took over, and on the first play Zarbaugh raced to

his own 47. Bailey took a hand-off from Long, moving to the Adrian 26. A Zarbaugh-to-Long pass was ruled complete on the 2 as the result of interference, and on the next play Smith bulled over for his second score.
