

# 3000 See Redmen Defeat Otterbein

Denison opened defense of its Ohio Conference co-championship with a 14-0 victory over Otterbein Saturday night in a game that attracted an overflow crowd of about 3000 fans to the first night game ever played under Otterbein's new lights.

An Otterbein fumble and a sustained drive gave Denison both touchdowns in the first half and then the Big Red had to hang on for dear life as the revitalized Cardinals played the Redmen's powerful split-T to a standstill the final two periods.

An Otterbein 72-yard drive died on the Denison four-yard line at the start of the fourth period and a 21-yard pass in the end zone was batted down by a Denison defender at the last moment on the final play of the game.
