

Wesleyan Is Easy Winner

Bishops Run Wild In 50-7 Victory Over Outmanned Otterbein

Ohio Wesleyan's battling Bishops were in top form Saturday as they trounced a weak Otterbein, 50-7, yesterday afternoon in Memorial Stadium at Westerville.

The Delaware eleven could manage only six points during the first fifteen minutes but scored at will from then on.

The first touchdown was scored by Jack Rauss as he broke loose for 54 yards and a TD.

Midway through the second period Bob Hancher's pass to Frank Lescinski was good for 40 yards to set up another OWU score. The ball was resting on the 15 when Carl Peggs went through the middle for 14 yards to the 1. Claude Kronk bucked over from there. Bob Stauffer's extra point was good.

The Bishops added one more TD in the second period when Chuck Hanlon tossed a 21 yard TD pass to Frank Lescinski. Lowell Benson added the extra point and the score was 20-0 at the half.

In the third period Wesleyan scored two quick touchdowns when Carl Peggs climaxed a 74 yard drive with a 6 yard end sweep. Bob Hancher kick the extra point. Minutes later Bill Wolfe intercepted Ron Smith's pass and hiked 25 yards to the 6. Jack Rauss scored on the next play. Benson kicked the extra point for a 34-0 lead.

Midway through the period the Otterbein fans got the thrill of the afternoon as Gahannan Freshman Bob White grabbed a OWU lateral on his own 30 and raced 70 yards for the Otters lone score. White is the heaviest man on the Cardinal squad at 235. Earl Belcher kicked the extra point.

Three plays later, OWU's Lowell Benson scooted around end for 45 yards and one more score. He also added the extra point and the third period ended with the Bishops leading, 41-7.

At the halfway mark of the fourth period Otterbein's Bob Fowler found himself trapped behind his own goal and the Wesleyan subs had added two more points to their score as Stan Doore made the tackle.

The subs scored again minutes later as Ed Ullman waded through eleven prospective tacklers only to break loose for 35 yards and a score. Bob Stauffer added the extra point and gave the Bishops their final score, 50-7.

Otterbein was outclassed all the way as the winners had 17 first downs to 3 for Otterbein. Wesleyan gained 334 yards on the ground to Otterbein's 21.
