

# Otterbein, Denison In First Losses

Big weekend developments on the Ohio college front were Wooster's 19-7 win over Denison, and Mt. Union's triumph by the same score over Otterbein.

The losses, first for each team, knocked them out of the Ohio conference leadership. It was Mount's first conquest.

Bowling Green and Bluffton stayed atop the statewide standings by winning their fifth games, the Bee-Gees 32-21 over Baldwin Wallace and the Beavers 41-0 over Defiance.

Findlay, leading the state in scoring with 198 points in four starts, grabbed the undisputed lead in the mid-Ohio loop by whaling Wilmington 55-6.

MIAMI WAS a 21-14 winner over Marshall to ease into a tie with Bowling Green for the mid-American conference lead with a 2-0 record, all the others having been beaten.

Xavier's Musketeers trounced Cincinnati 34-14 for the Queen City championship, and Dayton was victimized 13-0 by Villanova in other big ones.
