### ***Campaign Boosts Football Crowd***

The Otterbein College "O" Club's effort to lift football game attendance out of the doldrums succeeded in the first effort.

The 2500 seats were filled and about 500 were standing to watch the Otters hold powerful Denison to a 14-0 win Saturday night.

A crowd of 1500 was a "good crowd" in the past, said Edwin Rousch of Westerville, co-chairman of the "O" Club's project.

Games have always been played Saturday afternoons and suffered from Ohio State University football competition, Rousch explained.

The club installed lights around the field to permit Saturday night play in return for 300 reserved-seat tickets for five years. The club sold the tickets for \$25 each to help pay for the lights. Rousch said the tickets were all sold.
