Shock waves of the Wittenberg football ineligibility disaster are still being felt throughout the staid Ohio Conference. Particularly troubled are those working on future schedules when the conference will play in divisions with a post season title clash. Division membership is being determined by the records of the teams in recent years in a sincere effort to afford balance.

But if the Tigers go from 9-0 to 0-9 their position in the schedule scheme would change to the pleasure of some and the discomfort of others.

Still the incident, in which a player had not registered and did not attend classes for the most of three months, carries the "difficult to believe" label. While the chorus of "how could that happen?" continues, other schools have taken measures to shore up their eligibility communication network.
